Notice of said meeting was sent to the Mercury Gazette on April 13, 2016, with same notice being posted on the same date at the Town Hall and on the Town website.

Supervisor Evans called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 pm.

Supervisor Evans stated we are here to have a public hearing on Local Law 1-2016 titled "A Local Law for Appointing Constables for the Town of Lyndon of Cattaraugus County" The legislative purpose is to allow the Town Board of the Town of Lyndon the authorization to appoint not more than 4 civil officers who shall be known as "constables" and who shall possess all the powers and duties of constables in civil and criminal actions and proceedings.

Public Comment-

A Resident asked what are constables? Supervisor Evans stated they are trained to do the job. Clerk Puglisi stated all of the Constables are trained with each weapon they use and get recertified each year with them. They are also trained to work metal detectors for court and can do everything except serve an arrest warrant. Supervisor Evans stated the town and court feel much safer when they are here especially during a contentious court case.

Being no more public comment Councilman Gietl made a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Councilman Evans seconded the motion. All Ayes the public hearing was adjourned at 7:07 pm.
