Notice of said meeting was sent to the Mercury Gazette on May 2, 2016, with same notice being posted on the same date at the Town Hall.

Supervisor Evans called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm with the Pledge to the Flag.

Supervisor Evans stated we are here to have a public hearing on Local Law 2-2016 titled "A Local Law Regulating Peddling/Vending and Soliciting in the Town of Lyndon." The legislative purpose is to regulating itinerant merchandising and soliciting in the Town of Lyndon in order to maintain the peace, health, safety, welfare and good order in the Town and so that its inhabitants shall not be endangered or unduly disturbed.

Section 2B was removed from the law and after speaking with the Town Attorney he said it would not pertain to the Amish.
